| 6 | Divyangian(Blind/Deaf and Dumb and Physically handicapped) | 2% |
| 7 | Wards/Widow of Para military/Punjab police personnel expired during action | 2% |
| 8 | Wards/Widow of co-duty expired defense personnel | 2% |
| 9 | For the wards of Migrant Sikhs /internal migrants and external migrants | 2% |
| 10 | Widow /Divorced women | 2% |

Note: If candidates are not available in the above mentioned reserved categories, the seats so available will be filled by the students of general categories. The students are hereby informed to specify their category on the top of their admission form, otherwise their admission forms will be considered under general category.



Reservation of seats for various categories of candidates for admission to the degree-level courses in Engineering and Technology in various Colleges, including MBA, MCA and B.Pharmacy as well as diploma-level courses in Polytechnic Institutions and certificate courses in ITI's in the State of Punjab from the session 2013-2014.

Reference to Punjab Government, Memo No.13/2/05-17E2/410 Dated 20.2 06, on the subject noted above

The alloresaid Reservation Policy has been reviewed and it has been decided to retain the previous palicy in terms of substantive percentages of reservation for the various categories. The percentage of reservation for each of the categories shall be as

(If suitable candidates are not available in anyone of these sub-categories the seats so available will be filled up by the candidates from the other sub categories of disabled candidates and if they are not available in any subcategory then seats shall be filled up from general category candidates)

Children/widows of defence personnel killed or disabled to the extent of 50% or more in action, wards of galantry awardces, children of serving defence personnel/ex-servicemen (2%). The priority to this category is given as under

(8) Killed in action

(b) Disabled in action & Boarded out of service.

Died while in service & death attributable to military service (c)

Tell Disabled in service & Boarded out of service with disability attributable

Gallantry award/other award winners both serving/retired

Serving Defence Personnel/Ex-servicemen

Children/widows of Para-military forces personnel, Punjab Police, PAP and Punjab Home Guards killed or disabled in action to the extent of 50% or more, and children of parametery forces personnellex-paramilitary forces personnel, wards of Punjab Policemen decorated with Gallantry Medals (2%)

November 1984 nots-affected displaced persons, children of the Army deserters killed/100% physically disabled, children of the families of persons killed as a result of terrorist violence or by security forces acting in aid of civil authorities and the children of innocent civilians who have sustained 100% disability in terrorist violence or during operation by Security forces acting in aid of givit authorities [2%].

The reservation of T-Sunami affected persons shall be available for the children/grand children of original ex-serviceman settler of Campbell Bay Island only or Student suffering from Cancer/AIDS/Thalassemia (The claimant candidate will have to submit a certificate as a proof from the National Medical Institute tike PGI. AIMS etc. in support of his/her claim)

The aforesaid percentage reservation in respect of each category small however, be subject to the detailed clarifications and inter se gradation orderia as decided in the meeting chaired by Chief Secretary to the Government of Punjab on 13th March, 2003. the minutes of which are appended. These minutes and the decisions recorded therein shall be treated as a part and parcel of this communication

Nothing in the aforesaid policy shall apply to the courses run by the three universities in the state other than Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar, in respect of the courses offered by them in their campuses or their regional centres. Admission to these courses shall be governed by the reservation policy framed by the respective University

These policy instructions shall be subject to the law laid down by the honourable Suprame Court of India in the case of TMA Pai Foundation and others vs. State of Karnataka and others (2002) 8SCC481 AIR2003 SC 355)

You are requested to implement the above reservation policy in all the Professional/Engineering Colleges/Polytechnic Institutions/Industrial Training Institutes and Technical Institutes in the State

NOTIFICATION

The 12th April 2017

No.3/12/17-RC1/96.-As per Punjab Government letter No.1946-WG-54/17248, dated 17th March, 1954 and letter No. 1637-WCI-AS2-64/4289, dated 6th/13th March, 1964, 20% and 2% seats were severyed for the members of Scheduled Castes/Tribes and Backward Classes in educational, Technical and Professional Institutions at the time of admission.

- Keeping in view the population figures in 1974 which have been shown an increase of 5%, the Government decided to increase reservation quota in Educational, Technical and Professional Institutions from 20% to 7 5% in case of members of Scheduled Castes and from 2% to 5% in case of members of Backward Classes for admission purpose in these institutions vide Punjab Government letter No. 4933-SWI-74/21145 dated 6th November, 1974.
- The Governor of Punjab is pleased to increase the reservation quota/percentage for Backward Classes from 5% to 10% for admissions in Educational, Technical and Professional Institutions in the State of Punjab.
- This Notification shall come into force with immediate effect.
